FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your entry.

Langrish is about a mile and half to the west of Petersfield. The paddock and trials site are on the north side of the A272 and on the western fringe of Langrish village (map ref 197/SU702240, post code GU32 1QY). The A272 is a very BUSY road, so please access and exit the site with great care. If coming from the WEST (Winchester) the entrance to the site is just after a left hand downhill bend, so please approach at slow speed – signs (! SLOW ! Trailers Turning) will be positioned on the verge.

The Highways Agency has, over the last few weekends, closed Junction 5 of the A3M. This is where the A3M and the A27 connect. It is advisable to avoid it.

Any passenger or marshal under the age of 18 must produce a letter of permission from their parent or guardian which should be lodged with the Secretary of the Meeting at signing on. An adult who is responsible for them must also sign the MSA form on the day. Drivers must produce a valid Competition License and valid membership card from the organising club or one of the invited clubs. All passengers must produce a valid membership card from the organising club or one of the invited clubs.
